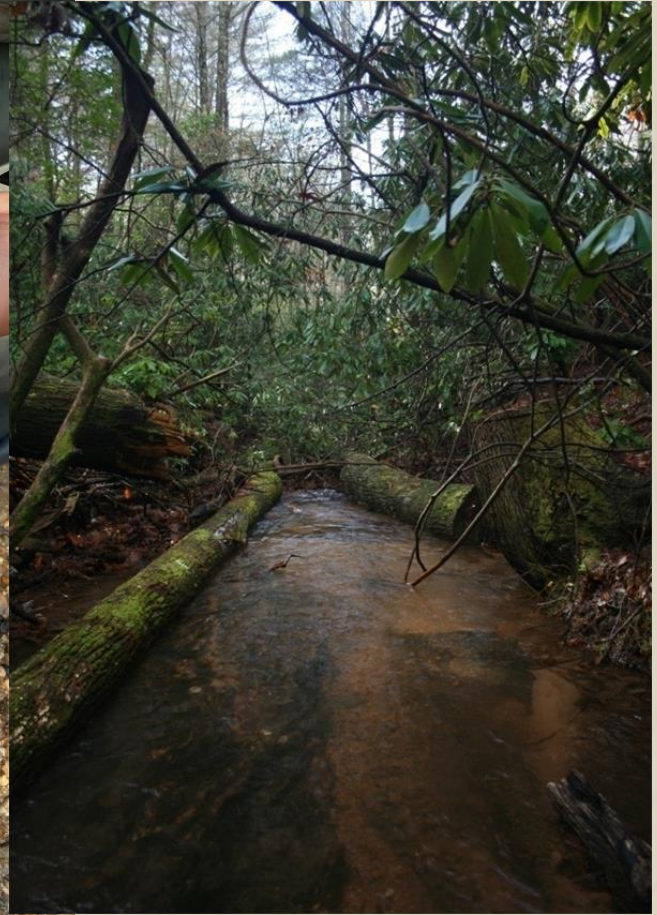
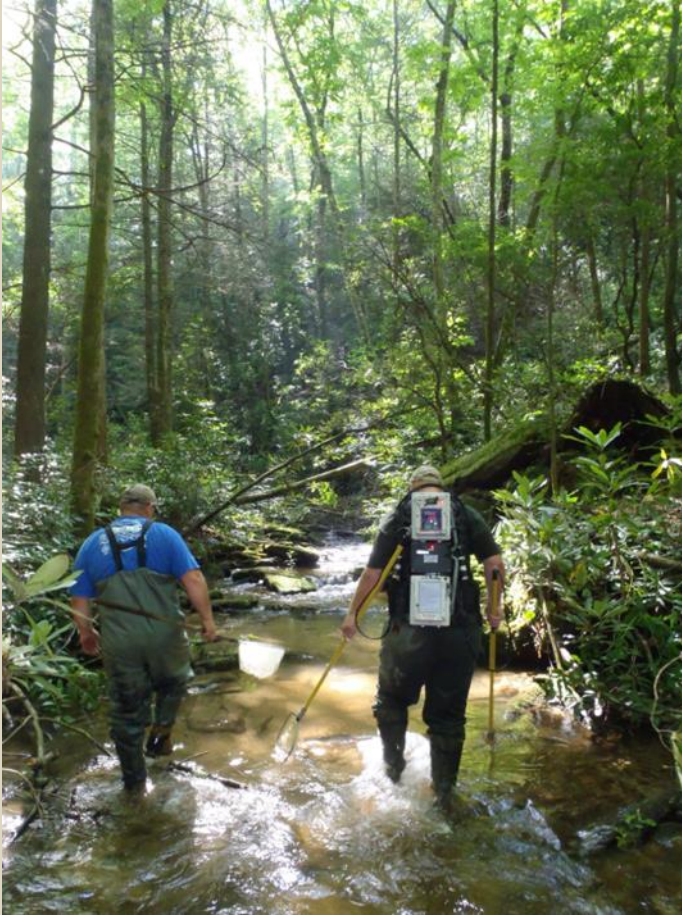

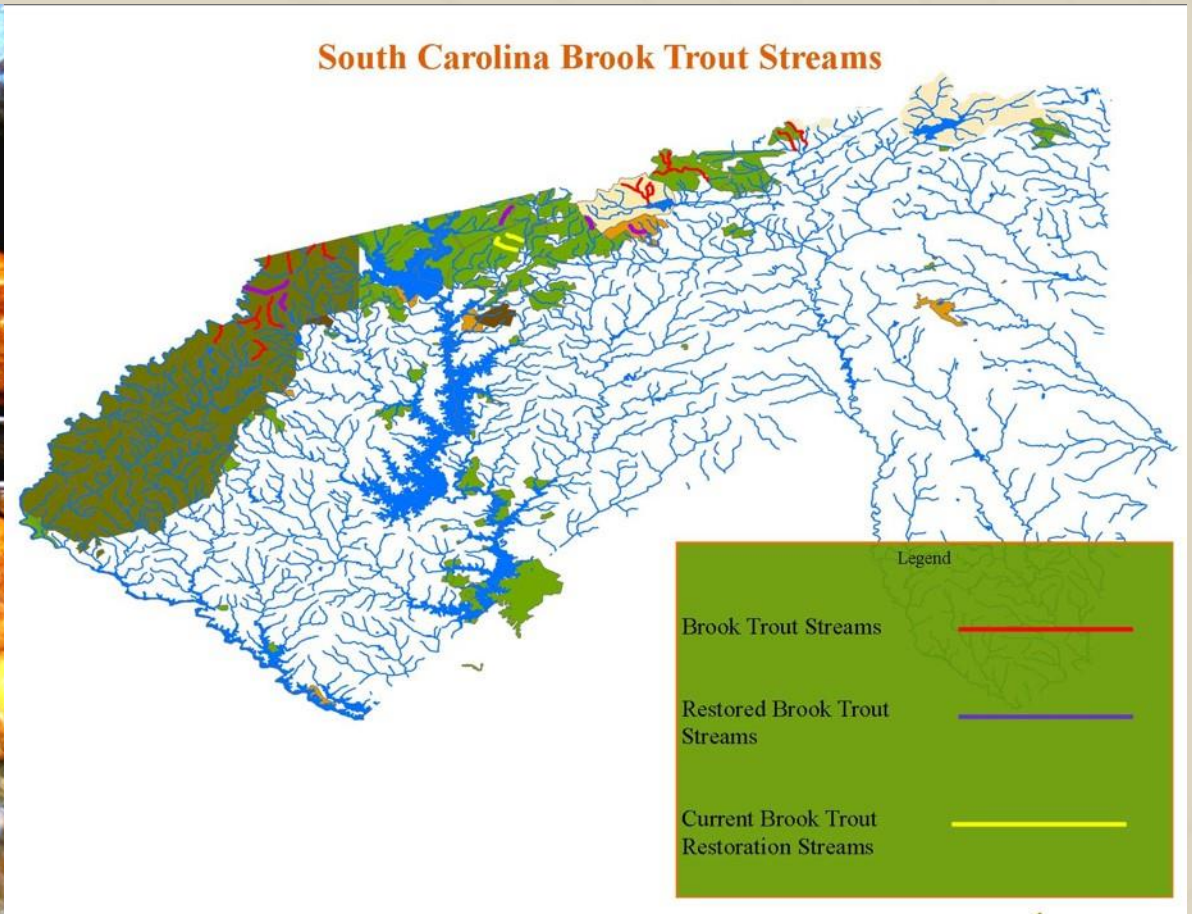

Trout Stocking



- Approximately 500,000 trout stocked annually
- Mix of Rainbow, Brook, and Brown Trout stocked
- Waters stocked in the Saluda River Basin:
 - North, Middle, and South Saluda and tributaries
 - Mountain Lakes: Pleasant Ridge County Park, Tall Pines WMA pond, and Lake Pinnacle at Table Rock State Park

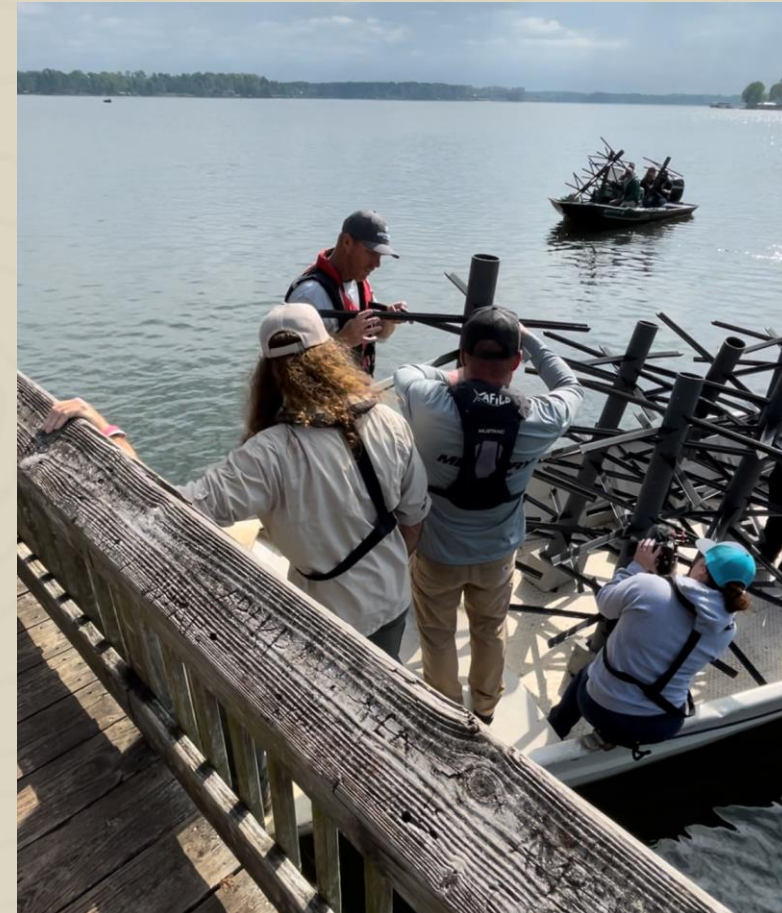

- Lake Greenwood Creel Surveys:
 - 2021-2022 creel survey
 - Economic Impact: approximately \$2.8 million spent by anglers
- Lake Greenwood Creel – July 2022 – June 2023
- Saluda River Creel – from Buzzards Roost dam to headwaters of Lake Murray
 - July 2023- June 2024
