INSTRUCTIONS – DHEC 3236

<u>PURPOSE:</u> The *Fiscal Sustainability Plan Certification* is used to certify that a Clean Water (CW) SRF Project Sponsor has complied with the actions required by Section 603(d)(1)(E) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (FWPCA), as seen on Page 1 of this form.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Pursuant to Section 603(d)(1)(E) of the FWPCA, CWSRF Project Sponsors must certify that the system has a fiscal sustainability plan (FSP) that covers the SRF-funded treatment works or that Section 603(d)(1)(E) of the FWPCA does not apply to the project. EPA interpretation allows for the FSP to be developed during the course of construction. The FSP will not be submitted to DHEC, but DHEC and/or EPA may request to see a copy.

Section 603(d)(1)(E) requires that there be an FSP that covers only the SRF-funded treatment work. However, as a best practice, systems are encouraged to develop a system-wide FSP over time and to regularly review and update the FSP document.

Definition of "Treatment works" [per 2014 amendment to FWPCA section 212(2)(A)]:

The term "treatment works" means any devices and systems used in the storage, treatment, recycling, and reclamation of municipal sewage or industrial wastes of a liquid nature to implement section 201 of this Act, or necessary to recycle or reuse water at the most economical cost over the estimated life of the works, including intercepting sewers, outfall sewers, sewage collection systems, pumping, power, and other equipment, and their appurtenances; extensions, improvements, remodeling, additions, and alterations thereof; elements essential to provide a reliable recycled supply such as standby treatment units and clear well facilities; and acquisition of the land that will be an integral part of the treatment process (including land use for the storage of treated wastewater in land treatment systems prior to land application) or will be used for ultimate disposal of residues resulting from such treatment and acquisition of other land, and interests in land, that are necessary for construction.

Note: The Project Sponsor's final draw request will not be processed until a certification has been submitted and reviewed by DHEC.

<u>INSTRUCTIONS:</u> The Project Sponsor's Representative enters the project information and signs the appropriate certification on Page 1 of the form (i.e., Item 1 or Item 2). When Item 1 is signed the FSP Summary on Page 2 must be filled out and submitted with Page 1.

Item 1 is for projects that are required to complete an FSP pursuant to Section 603(d)(1)(E) of the FWPCA. An FSP is required for a Clean Water State Revolving Fund project that involves repair, replacement, or expansion of a treatment works. The FSP is required to cover only the SRF-funded treatment works. Note that the FSP Summary on Page 2 of this form may not be adequate to constitute an FSP. Length and detail of an FSP is dependent upon the size and scope of the treatment works system.

Item 2 is for projects that are <u>not</u> required to complete an FSP pursuant to Section 603(d)(1)(E) of the FWPCA. FSPs are not required for new treatment works (unless they are physically replacing an existing treatment works or expanding the treatment capacity of an existing system) or projects that include an upgrade that does not involve repair/replacement or expand the treatment capacity (e.g., adding advanced treatment).

Please submit the FSP Certification form to the designated DHEC SRF Project Manager by email or by mail to SRF Section - Water Facilities Permitting Division, S.C. DHEC, 2600 Bull Street, Columbia, SC 29201. The form can be submitted at any time during project construction, or, at the latest, at the time of the final draw request.

<u>DHEC REVIEW AND FILING:</u> The SRF Section will use this form to document compliance with Section 603(d)(1)(E) of the FWPCA by a CWSRF project. The form will be kept in the Loan file for the named project and will be retained for three years following the final SRF disbursement to the Project Sponsor - per DHEC Retention Schedule 15795.
