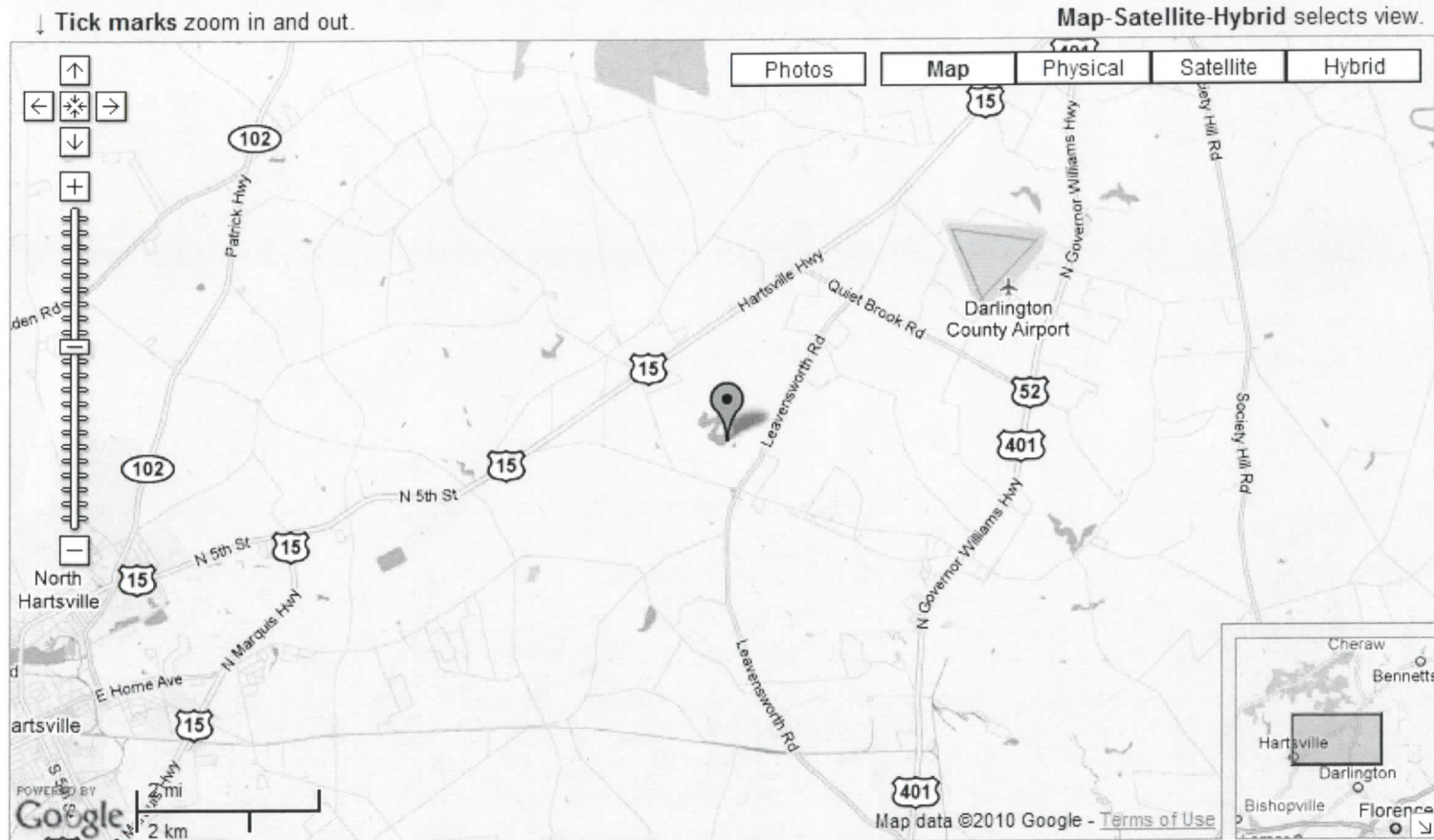


South Carolina Noname 16006 D-3533 Dam - South Carolina

Dear Mr. Atkinson,

On December 22, 2010, I met with you to discuss the Chapman Pond Dam and to determine compliance with the Dams and Reservoirs Safety Act Regulation 72-1 thru 72-9. During our meeting you indicated that this dam had been breached for over 10 years. You also mentioned that you wanted to keep this structure on our inventory and your hopes were to rebuild it when financial arrangements could be made.

As we discussed, any efforts to rebuild this dam would need to be approved by SCDHEC – Bureau of Water staff. Once you are able to rebuild, you will need to get a qualified engineer to design this structure. For information on this process, please contact Steven Bradley in our Columbia office at 803-898-4027.

As information, provisions in the Dams and Reservoirs Safety Act Regulation 72-1 thru 72-9 require the owner to notify the Department within 30 days after transferring title or control of the dam. The enclosed notification form must include the name and address of the new owner when control of the dam is transferred and must be submitted to Region 4 – Florence EQC office.

Also note that as of July 25, 1997, it is the responsibility of the dam owner to notify any downstream property owners in the event of a failure or near-failure of the dam. An area has been supplied on the enclosed form for you to record the names, addresses, and telephone numbers of downstream property owners. A separate enclosure may need to be used to include all of the affected property owners. Please insure that the information on the Emergency Notification Plan is kept current. This should include updating the names and telephone numbers of the agencies listed on the Plan so that they can provide assistance if an emergency occurs. Please return a completed copy of the Emergency Notification Plan by **February 1, 2011** to the Region 4 – Florence EQC office at the address provided in the footer below.
