Dear Ms. Danner:

The results for the referenced tests have been reviewed by the Department. Since the CEMS report emissions are based on mass, the flow monitor was inherently included in determining relative accuracy. All monitors meet the relative accuracy requirements of 40 CFR Part 60 Appendix B.

The Furnaces RATA testing was completed March 1-3, 2016. Johnson Controls did not submit a complete written notification until March 4, 2016. Failure to submit a notification to the Department at least two weeks prior to conducting future source tests may result in a violation of S.C. Regulation 61-62.1, Section IV Source Tests.
