Re: New-Indy stack test and request for notification waiver

Dear Mr. Hobson:

The Department has received your letter dated September 9, 2021, and the included stack test plan. The letter requests approval to conduct testing the week of September 27, 2021, and that the Department waive its requirement to submit a complete written notification at least two weeks in advance of the intended date to conduct the stack test. The referenced test is not a Department required test; however, since New Indy Catawba intends to submit the results to the Department for review, it must follow the procedures outlined in SC 61-62.1, Section IV, Source Tests. The Department hereby grants a waiver of the stack testing notification requirements for testing described herein, contingent upon the submitted plan being sufficient for the Department's timely approval of the stack test plan.

This waiver and any subsequent test plan approval should not be construed as acceptance of New Indy's premise for conducting this additional testing. Further, the testing and resulting data will not be considered a replacement test and will not supersede the data from the June 21-27, 2021, testing. Data from both tests will be evaluated independently and utilized as the Department deems appropriate.
