Dear Mr. Dempsey,

The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) has reviewed the above referenced documents. The results of the Air Sparge Test indicate the Shallow Bedrock Zone has insufficient fracture apertures/density to permit air flow sufficient for air sparging to be effective. The area will continue to be monitored through routine groundwater sampling events as outlined in the *Groundwater and Surface Water Monitoring and Reporting Plan Approval (April 1, 2020 through March 31, 2021*) dated August 13, 2020. Additional remedial methods may be required in the future if chemical of concern concentrations increase or free phase product is detected in the area.
