
The purpose of this training is for users to learn how to sign up for Alerts about events in ePermitting.

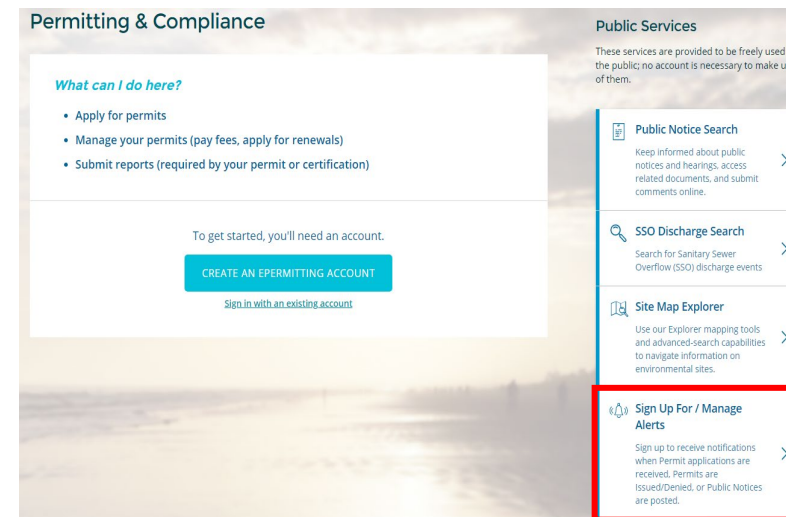
Managing Alerts
